ORDER

- 1). This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 filed by Shri Licha Tabia & Shri Nabam Pekhi, Vill Dem. PO Deed, Ps Yachuli, Keyi Panor District, Arunachal Pradesh, for non-furnishing of information by the PIO-cum-BDO, CD Block Pistana, Keyi Panor District, Arunachal Pradesh, as sought by the Appellant under section 6(1) of RTI Act, 2005 vide Form-A Dated 08/05/2025 regarding total sanctioned order copy for all the beneficiaries of Dem Panchayat under MGNREGA.
- 2). The 3rd hearing was held on 10th February 2026 (Tuesday) at 1100 hrs. Shri John Diru, PIO-cum-BDO, CD Block Pistana, Keyi Panor District, Arunachal Pradesh was present through Video Conferencing. The Appellant Shri Nabam Pekhi & Shri Licha Tabia were present.
- 3). The Appellant submitted that the PIO had not furnished complete and detailed information and raising question on the information provided by the PIO.
- 4). Shri John Diru, PIO-Cum- BDO, CD Block Pistana informed the Commission that he had furnished whatever document were available with the office and the remaining information as sought by the Appellant vide letter No. PST/BDO/RTI/2025 Dated Pistana, the 21st November' 2025 had been sent officially to the Appellant i.e Licha Tabia with a copy endorsed to the Commission.
- 5). The Appellant Shri Licha Tabia denied having received the information however, the PIO insisted that he had a confirmation message report of the Appellant.
- 6). The Commission handed over an information xerox copy to the Appellant and directed to go through in detail. The Appellant is directed to intimate the Commission in writing, his satisfaction or dissatisfaction on the information so provided within 20 days from the date of issue of this order.

8). The next date of hearing would be decided on the basis of intimation from the Appellant. In case Appellant failed to intimate to the Commission within 20 days from the date of issue of this order the case shall be disposed of.
