An Appeal Case U/S 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005

Case No. APIC-374/2025.

APPELLANT : Ms. Bengia Mama, Dariya Hill colony, Itanagar.

RESPONDENT : The PIO, o/o the EE (PWD), Sagalee Division.

ORDER

This is an appeal under Section 19(3) of RTI Act, 2005 received from Ms. Bengia Mama for non-furnishing of below mentioned information by the PIO, o/o the Executive Engineer (PWD), Sagalee Division, Papum Pare District (A.P) as sought for by her under section 6(1) (Form-A) of RTI Act, 2005 vide her application dated 20.01.2025.

• **A) Particular of information:** c/o Wire Rope Suspension Bridge order Parang river Between Silsango to Govt. Middle School, Kuch Kute in Papum Pare District Arunachal Pradesh.

B) Details of information required:

1. Furnish a copy of Sanction Order.
2. Furnish a copy of the Details Project Report (DPR).
3. Furnish Work order
4. Furnish TS copy
5. Furnish Geo Tagging details in colouring photos
6. Furnish detail copies of Material Procurement of Challans
7. Furnish Photograph of project before during and after the completion of the project in coloring photo
8. Furnish Payment Cheque leaf/ PFMS/DBT transaction receipt copy
9. Furnish Letter of Credit (LOC)
10. Furnish Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) details with NEWS paper cutting.
11. Furnish the Name of bidder with detail supporting documents of the same.
12. Furnish Name of all the tender participants with detail documents.
13. Name of the Officers involved in the said project.
14. Furnish a copy of Approved drawing & assurance letter from the NIT.
15. Furnish details on the grounds for rejection of the technical bids of all bidders who were disqualified in the evaluation process. This should include specific deficiencies or non-compliances with the tender requirements.
16. Furnish copies of the contractor licenses of the selected bidders, including the date of registration and any relevant updates or renewals.
17. Furnish Completion Certificate.
18. Furnish Utilization Certificate.
19. Furnish details of monthly monitoring report from Directorate Office, SJETA.

20. Furnish all the documents in proper paging with CTC in each page and please to furnish within 30 days from the date of receipt as per RTI act otherwise the appellant is not liable to pay any fees as per sub-section (6) of the Section (7), RTI Act, 2005.

C) Period for which information is sought for: 2023 to 2024.

Facts emerging from the appeal and the decision:

Records in the appeal reveal that the appellant, Ms Bengia Mama, vide her application dt.20.01.2025, had requested the PIO but failed to obtain the same which prompted her to file her 1st appeal before the Director, Social Justice, Empowerment and Tribal Affairs, Itanagar as the First Appellate Authority (FAA) u/s-19(1) vide her Memo of Appeal dt.13.03.2025 but she could not get positive response from the FAA. As such she filed her 2nd appeal before this Commission under section 19(3) of the RTI Act vide her Memo of Appeal dt.08.05.2025. Her appeal was, however, remanded to the FAA by the Registry of this Commission vide letter dt.14.06.2025 for adjudication and passing and appropriate order. The appellant, however, vide her letter dt.13.04.2026, intimated that the FAA did not conduct the hearing and hence, pleaded this Commission to take up the appeal.

- This appeal is, accordingly, registered and listed for hearing in this Commission today on 21.08.2026, but the appellant has informed that she will not be able to attend the hearing today as she is pre-occupied with the SIR hearing and requested for adjournment of the hearing. The PIO is, however, represented by Er. Sri Haj Yarang, AE-cum-APIO in person.

Heard the APIO who submitted that the appellant has already been furnished with the requested information/documents vide PIO's letter dt.03.07.2026 a copy whereof has also been produced by him during the course of hearing which has been retained in this Commission. The APIO also brought in some of the left out information, such as the copies of DPR and LOC.

This Commission noticed in the aforesaid PIO's letter that against some of the queries such as the material procurement challan (Sl.No6) and details of Monitoring report (Sl.No.19), the PIO has remarked as 'NA' which can not be accepted as replies/information under the RTI Act. The PIO is, therefore, required to furnish appropriate and specific replies/explanation on an affidavit against those queries.

Since the appellant is absent, the left out information/documents brought in by the APIO have been returned to the PIO and directed him to furnish the same to the appellant along with the affidavit as aforesaid within 2(two) weeks from the date of receipt of this order and the appellant shall, thereafter intimate this Commission of the receipt of the same within 1(one) week failing which this appeal shall stand closed without further notice.
